



DEAR FRIENDS, COLLEAGUES AND SUPPORTERS OF THE CAC,

The year 2019 was transformational for the Chicago Architecture Center as the organization soared to "new heights" of accomplishment. At the same time, the year's success laid groundwork for the CAC's rapid response to the unforeseeable events of 2020.

The Center's enhanced physical presence in the form of its new home at Illinois Center brought greater visibility to the CAC's growing role as a convener of—and leader within—local, regional and international communities. The centrality of this new location and its increased capacity for facilities and staff allowed the CAC to engage more individuals and families than ever in 2019.

Adding to awards it received the previous year from the AIA and Friends of Downtown, the Center was recognized in 2019 with the Magnificent Mile Association's "Business Impact of the Year" award. CAC President and CEO Lynn Osmond's influence expanded in 2019 with her appointment to the City of Chicago Landmarks Commission and the start of her term as Vice Chair of Choose Chicago.

Membership growth was among the CAC's great success stories of 2019, with total revenue exceeding \$1 million—marking an eight percent increase over blockbuster revenue numbers achieved in 2018. Average annual revenue per member household exceeded \$100 for the first time, and the organization closed 2019 with 13,633 members in total.

Extraordinary volunteer service and participation continued to provide bedrock support for the CAC, with more than 49,000 hours donated by more than 4,000 generous individuals. The CAC trained 80 new volunteers in 2019, providing them access to a variety of presentations and workshops for skill-building and professional development.

In June 2019, the CAC assembled a committee dedicated to IDEA: Inclusion, Diversity, Equity and Accessibility. Comprising representatives from all departments and various levels of the organization, the IDEA committee continually works to ensure the CAC is a welcoming environment for all people and reflects the dynamic variety of those who live in or visit Chicago.



Fully aligned with IDEA goals, the CAC Education programs for children and families awaken curiosity and advance quality learning in STEM subjects, with a longer-term objective of diversifying careers and leadership in architecture, construction, engineering and design. Educational offerings, both for children and adults, increased in frequency and participation during 2019.

Building on strong relationships with the media, CAC disseminated information about the activities outlined above, garnering press coverage that reinforced to the public the key messages and brand identities the CAC launched in 2018. This coverage generated as many as 2.19 billion impressions, the equivalent of approximately \$20 million in advertising dollars.

Reaching these heights would not have been possible without the hard work and steadfast support of the entire Chicago Architecture Center community. The CAC views with pride the accomplishments of 2019—detailed throughout this report—and looks forward to its continued success.

CENTER HIGHLIGHTS

Center admissions in 2019 totaled 134,771, with nearly 46% of those visitors also attending a CAFC River Cruise, CAC walking tour or bus tour. We were pleased that the Center was also the chosen venue for a number of high profile events that brought more than 9,000 guests, including dinners, cocktail receptions and corporate parties. Notable events included the Economic Club of Chicago's Fifth Night reception, a VIP reception and symposium hosted during the Council on Tall Buildings and Urban Habitat's World Congress, and a reception for the Federation of Women Contractors, attended by Chicago Mayor Lori Lightfoot.

In August, CAC staff and volunteers conducted the Center's first in-depth visitor survey and "follow-along" observations of guests in CAC galleries. Survey results show that guests are highly satisfied with their Center visits, with the Chicago City Model Experience ranking most popular among its exhibits.

EXHIBITS

The year began with an opportunity to partner with the Chicago Department of Aviation for a pop-up exhibition titled "Arriving at O'Hare: A New Global Terminal."

Over the course of six weeks in January and February, the CAC Orientation Hall welcomed a display of the finalists' entries in the City of Chicago's international competition to design the new O'Hare Global Terminal. The exhibition featured a public voting component on schemes created by esteemed firms from across the world, from Foster + Partners to Santiago Calatrava Architects & Engineers to Chicago teams headed by SOM and eventual winner Studio ORD (led by Studio Gang). It resulted in significant public attendance and media attention.

Gallery content was refreshed throughout the year, including a new "Current Projects" installation in the Chicago Gallery sponsored by Lendlease that highlighted new design-forward developments across the city. Two updates to the Chicago City Model, in spring and fall 2019, added six buildings to the more than 4,250 on display.

CENTER VOLUNTEERS

The Center experience was enhanced by 202 exhibit hosts and 91 guest services volunteers. Exhibit hosts contributed 5,800 hours and guest services volunteers contributed 1,800 hours in 2019.





CHICAGO PANORAMAS


A TOTAL OF 411,000 PEOPLE attended CAC tours in 2019, the most ever! We have become the premier navigator for individuals, families and groups eager to learn about Chicago's past and continuing architectural design heritage.

WALKING TOURS Nearly 39,000 people attended CAC walking tours in 2019. The CAC's two most popular walking tours were Historic Treasures and Chicago Architecture: A Walk Through Time. Union Station saw the highest attendance of any single-building tour, and Frank Lloyd Wright in Oak Park was the most popular neighborhood tour. There was a notable increase in the number of people attending Chicago Pedway tours, likely due to the CAC's relocation to Illinois Center. Walking tours introduced in 2019 included Elevated Architecture: North Side Art, Louis Sullivan Rediscovered, Magnificent Architecture of the Magnificent Mile and Uptown.



RIVER CRUISES

The Chicago Architecture Foundation Center River Cruise aboard Chicago's First Lady continued to be the CAC's most popular tour offering, both in attendance and earned revenue. 2019 marked the 26th anniversary of the two organizations' contractual relationship and river cruise attendance increased by 4% over 2018.



BUS TOURS

The CAC's annual "special edition" bus tours continued to be popular with CAC members and Chicagoans, selling out at an 88% rate overall. Like last year, the tour with the largest attendance in this series was Churches by Bus. CAC docents also developed a special bus tour as part of this series to honor the work and legacy of the late architect Stanley Tigerman. Our Neighborhoods by Bus partnership with Big Bus continued to address visitors' desire to explore our city in a dynamic way—on wheels! CAC bus tour attendance decreased overall, from 8,400 guests in 2018 to 7,500 in 2019.

DOCENT VOLUNTEERS

All tours are led by the CAC's docent volunteers, among Chicago's most highly respected volunteer corps. In 2019, this group included 451 active, emeritus and on-hiatus docents. More than 30 new docents were added to the corps as well, after spending nearly 12 weeks in training. Throughout 2019, 398 docents contributed 14,100 tour hours total.

GAINING PERSPECTIVE

IN 2019, the CAC Programs team worked to foster more informed and involved citizens, bolstering its reputation as a trusted source of information about the built environment. Programs for adults, numbering 38 in all, saw a 33% increase in attendees.

WHAT'S NEXT

This invitation-only, twice-annual forum aimed at C-suite decision-makers addressed issues that necessitate collaboration and alignment among leaders in business, design-related fields and city government. Panelists at the inaugural What's Next program in May 2019 included SOM urban planner Phil Enquist, former Treasury Secretary Hank Paulson, former IBM Fellow Kerrie Holley and United Nations representative Patricia Holly Purcell. What's Next, a multi-year series generously supported by Sandra L. Helton and Norman Edelson, drew a capacity audience.

ADULT EDUCATION CLASSES

The CAC launched the Vincent Scully Masterclass Series in April 2019 as a special addition to its Lifelong Learning initiatives and a prime opportunity to introduce a broader audience to architecture. The CAC sold more than 400 tickets to this inaugural three-part series, led by guest lecturer Reed Kroloff and sponsored by Ann and Richard Carr. Non-credited adult education classes included book talks with acclaimed authors and interactive workshops.

BUILDING TALL

Co-hosted with the Council on Tall Buildings and Urban Habitat, these lectures explored key considerations in tall building design, both now and into the future. A total of 374 people attended three programs, including one special evening event that celebrated the 50th anniversary of 875 North Michigan Avenue (formerly the John Hancock Center), with three of the project's original architects and engineers.

ARCHITECT TALKS

Sponsored by Related Midwest, these lectures invited luminaries from multiple design-related fields to share the evolution of their work throughout their esteemed careers. Visiting presenters included the late Stanley Tigerman and, in a special 2019 Chicago Architecture Biennial edition, architect Jha D. Williams on MASS Design Group's Gun Violence Memorial Project.

DESIGN DIALOGUES

This series of evening lectures on timely design trends and local planning issues welcomed 312 attendees to three events. Topics included the future of Chicago's public spaces and the city's Historic Resources Survey.

DAYTIME TALKS

The CAC's popular series of monthly midday lectures included presentations on a best-selling biography of Philip Johnson and the latest advances in passive house construction. The series attracted 1,274 attendees to 11 events.

CURRENT PROJECTS

This series highlighted significant new project starts or completions in Chicago, including a memorable and uplifting program on the potential renovation of the storied Uptown Theatre. Three Current Projects events attracted 371 total attendees.

BEHIND-THE-SCENES TOURS

A total of 122 people attended two behind-the-scenes events, hosted at Farm on Ogden, the city's latest community-led urban architecture initiative, and the Elmhurst Art Museum, in conjunction with its exhibition "The Whole World a Bauhaus."

SPECIAL PROGRAMS

In addition to the core program attendees numbered above, 771 people attended six partner programs in 2019. Highlights included a game of "Architecture Jeopardy" co-presented with WBEZ's Curious City team, and a special architecture-themed Midwest Roadtrips program, produced in partnership with WTTW personality and CAC docent Geoffrey Baer.



OPEN HOUSE CHICAGO

OCT 19-20, 2019

The CAC's ninth annual **Open House Chicago** attracted 109,000 attendees who made 370,000 total site visits to 352 sites in 39 Chicago neighborhoods, plus Evanston and Oak Park. CAC staff estimate that OHC is the second-most widely attended event of its kind in the world. OHC 2019 was made possible through the generous support of Wintrust as the Presenting Sponsor, the Art Works program of the National Endowment for the Arts, ComEd, TAWANI Property Management and the City of Chicago's Department of Cultural Affairs and Special Events. Media sponsors included *Chicago* magazine, the *Chicago Tribune*, WBEZ and Vocalo. Additional partners included Choose Chicago, the Chicago Transit Authority and the Open House Worldwide family of events.



EXTENDING HORIZONS

THE CAC'S EDUCATION DEPARTMENT had a banner year in 2019, working to refine existing successful programs for even greater impact while piloting new initiatives that take advantage of the new Center's stimulating galleries. In all, CAC Education programs served 35,128 captivated individuals!

FAMILIES

The CAC's programs for children ages 3–14 and their families reached 14,600 people in 2019 through field trips, camps and classes, festivals and special events, school visits and gallery activations. This represents a 46% increase over 2018.

Nearly 60 students participated in Girls Build! programs, which provide girls ages 11–14 with opportunities to develop leadership skills, collaborate on place-based research and meet female architects and role models. The participants explored the built environments of Pilsen, Bronzeville and Little Italy during weekend classes, spring break camps and summer camps.

Festivals and special events at the CAC—and in partnership with city agencies and other organizations—reached 5,382 participants in 2019. Highlights included Engineering Fest, where children built Ferris wheels and explored the World's Columbian Exposition of 1893; and Open House Chicago, during which the CAC engaged learners at the Center and the Jay Pritzker Pavilion in nearby Millennium Park.

TEENS

The CAC reached 3,302 youth through Teen Fellows and Teen Ambassadors programs, design competitions, field trips, open studios, school visits and the Chicago Architecture Biennial. In 2019, 19 Teen Fellows—most from populations traditionally underrepresented in architecture, construction, engineering and design—met on Saturdays during the academic year to meet professionals, work on their design projects and visit significant architectural sites.

They also took a study trip to New York City and participated in paid summer internships. Neighborhood Teen Ambassadors, a two-year project funded by the National Endowment for the Humanities, served 15 youths in 2019. During a weeklong summer program and fall workshops, teens explored the architecture and history of Bronzeville through visits to historically significant sites and produced podcasts about their experiences.







EDUCATORS

The CAC held its annual Educator Reception in October, where more than 100 educators learned how to use the Center and its resources to support K–12 education. Professional development workshops also engaged nearly 50 new educators on how to use the *No Small Plans* graphic novel in their curricula, with 5,766 free copies distributed to students.

In addition, 38 teachers participated in two professional development workshops to learn about the Chicago Architecture Biennial's core themes, how to plan field trips, and about pre- and post-visit activities to engage students back in their classrooms.

OTHER 2019 EDUCATION INITIATIVES

O 2019 CHICAGO ARCHITECTURE BIENNIAL

The CAC once again served as the Signature Education Partner for the Chicago Architecture Biennial. Over three months (and despite an 11-day CPS teacher strike), the CAC served 3,086 diverse young Chicagoans, their teachers and families through field trips, teacher resources, workshops, gallery interpretation and the BP Student Ideas Competition. In partnership with After School Matters and the Chicago Architecture Biennial, the CAC also prepared 20 Teen Ambassadors to serve as interpreters and guides for the Biennial.


- O CHICAGO ARCHITECTURE EDUCATION NETWORK The CAC published a first-of-its-kind report that identified Chicago's out-of-school-time architecture and design programs. It was recognized by the Mayor's office as a model for other education constituencies and served as the foundation for the CAC-led Chicago Architecture Education Network (CAEN).
- O 37TH ANNUAL NEWHOUSE ARCHITECTURE + DESIGN COMPETITION Nearly 800 students from 36 schools worked on Newhouse projects in seven categories. Nearly 40 architecture and design professionals juried these students' work; winners received certificates, cash prizes and gifts donated by architecture firms in a showcase at the Center in May 2019.
- VOLUNTEER ENGAGEMENT The Education department led two trainings for 17 new education guides, and two additional trainings for current education guides who led Chicago Architecture Biennial field trips. In total, 53 education guide volunteers contributed 1,130 total hours to the CAC in 2019.
- DISCOVERDESIGN.ORG An online platform where students, teachers and mentors can participate in or develop design challenges, DiscoverDesign.org served 13,581 registered users in 2019, a 17% increase over 2018.
- O NO SMALL PLANS CAC's engaging graphic novel continues to introduce students to the world of planning and design through the imagined perspectives of three Chicago students from different time periods. Through the CAC's efforts, this absorbing work is found in every Chicago Public Library branch and in many classrooms throughout the city.


